The Powers of Interdisciplinary Undergraduate Research

OLIN AUDITORIUM (OLIN 115)

The aim of this session is to showcase the values and benefits of cross-disciplinary research in undergraduate education. We will explore this topic in the context of Union's liberal arts model of education, which emphasizes the technical aspects and humanist aspects of interdisciplinarity in equal measure.

We will hear student perspectives on issues such as disability studies and archival research, the interface of environmental science and environmental engineering, and the historical reconstruction of mathematical techniques through computational methods. The participants have been selected by the Co-Directors of the Templeton Institute in partnership with Schaffer Library to showcase diverse views on interdisciplinary student research at the College.

This event brings together short (ten-minute) lightning talks on these topics, with roughly a half-hour discussion among panelists and with the audience. This special session will be introduced and moderated by our Steinmetz Day guest, Dr. D. Fox Harrell, Professor of Digital Media and Artificial Intelligence in the Comparative Media Studies Program and Computer Science and Artificial Intelligence Laboratory at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT). All are welcome to attend and join the conversation.







MARGARET SCHADLER



The Union community is mourning the death of Margaret Eleanor Horsfall Schadler, a resident of Niskayuna, N.Y., who made indelible contributions to the College during her time as a professor. She died April 18 at the age of 93.

Schadler, who earned a B.S. in biology from Cornell University in 1953 and worked in her field for the next several years, moved to Schenectady in 1957 with her husband, Harvey. Here they raised a family, and Schadler earned an M.S. and Ph.D. in biology from Union.

In addition to being an alumna, Schadler taught biology at Union for more than 25 years and served for many years as associate dean for undergraduate programs. In 1991, she helped establish one of the College's most beloved and important traditions— Steinmetz Symposium. Now in its 35th year, the day-long event has showcased the scholarly and creative works of countless students.
